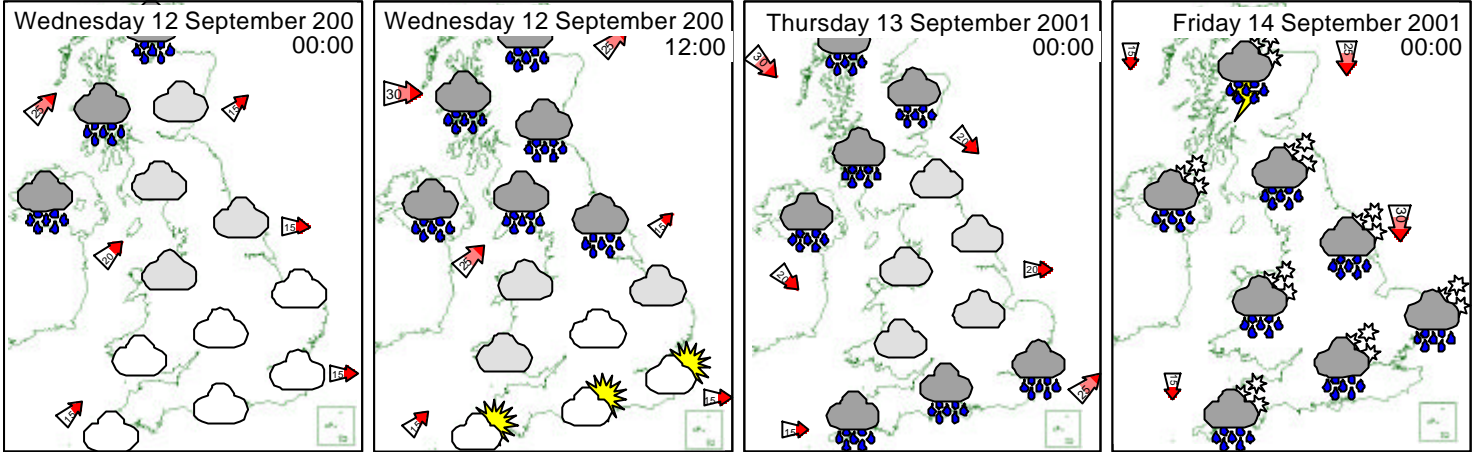
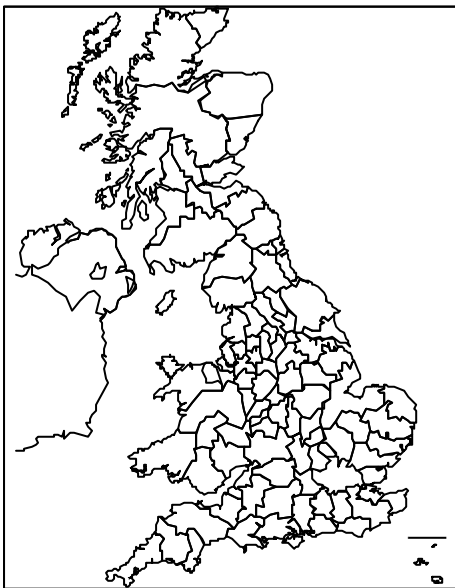


Forecast Sequence *This is a new warning. There are currently no other warnings or advisories in force.*



Rain will spread southwards from northern Scotland during the early hours of Wednesday and become heavier and more prolonged as it reaches Northern Ireland and northern England around noon. Winds will gust to gale force in upland areas and on exposed coasts. The heaviest rain is expected to occur in the afternoon over northeast England, the Pennines, East Midlands and North Wales giving totals of 10-15mm or more. There will be outbreaks of heavy rain in central and southeast England on Thursday morning, and blustery showers, occasionally with thunder may affect all areas during Thursday and into Friday. Northeastern Scotland and coasts in East Anglia and southeastern England may experience gusts of gale force during Friday.

Degree of Expected Damage

This episode of weather is not currently expected to cause significant damage to any major urban area of the UK. Exposed coasts in northwestern Scotland and in East Anglia may experience some minor isolated damage from gale force gusts on Wednesday and Friday respectively. Where heavy rain occurs there is the possibility of localised flooding.

Advisories refer to events that may cause disruption but that are not expected to cause significant amounts of property damage or generate large numbers of claims.

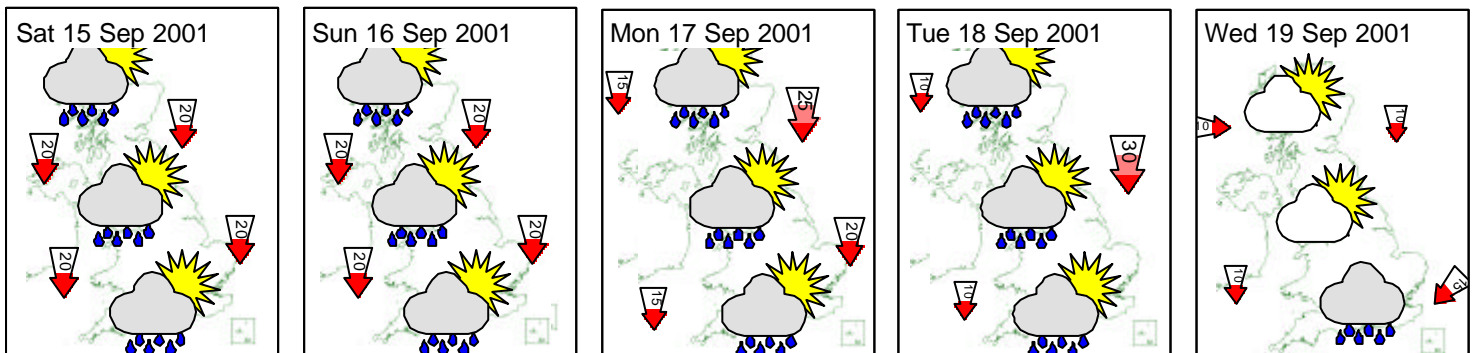
Warnings refer to weather events that are likely to generate significant numbers of claims.

Blustery showers, heavy in the north and east will continue to affect all areas over the weekend and into Monday. It will then become brighter in all areas except southeastern England which will have more rain with the possibility of strong winds.
